

## Information about donating

Dear supporter,

Thank you for your interest in the work of the Dr. Denis Mukwege Foundation, and for considering supporting our organisation with a donation.

The easiest and most straightforward way to make a donation is via our website:

This online donation page allows you to choose whether you want to make a one-time donation or a regular monthly donation, to choose the amount you want to donate, and to choose which payment option works best for you – useful if you are making your donation outside the EU. You'll also automatically get a receipt by email.

There is a drop-down menu under the words "I want to support" which allows you to choose either the Mukwege Foundation or Panzi Hospital in DRC. The main difference here is that the Mukwege Foundation works internationally to support survivors of conflict-related sexual violence. Panzi Hospital DRC is the hospital that Dr Mukwege set up more than 20 years ago in Bukavu, which continues to care for victims of sexual violence as well as offering general hospital services to the surrounding community. Where you decide to donate is entirely up to you – the donations made to Panzi Hospital DRC that we collect are forwarded by our finance department to the finance team at Panzi without any fees associated, so you know that your entire donation is supporting the cause that you've chosen.
